## Summer Camp and Junior Camp

With care available from 6:30 a.m. until 6:30 p.m. and breakfast, lunch, and an afternoon snack included, parents will never have to worry about the care of their child during those busy work days.

### Junior Camp

Our Junior Summer Camp is specifically targeted to our rising kindergarteners and first graders and includes structured activities designed to keep them challenged academically while keeping them entertained and engaged throughout the day! With fun themes such as Circus, Under the Sea, and Pirates, our Junior Campers enjoy a fun, educational, and safe summer.

Additionally, the kids will take field trips each Wednesday to places like the Chattahoochee Nature Center, Tellus Museum, and the Art Barn. Camp tee shirts and wristbands ensure a safe experience for them.

### Summer Camp

Our Summer Camp is designed for rising second through fifth grade children. The theme changes each summer to ensure continued interest, and activities are designed to inspire them to use their imaginations to create, explore, and learn about the world around them. A balance of teacher directed and child directed activities keeps them busy and engaged throughout the day. Additional learning activities each day will help to sharpen the skills they use during the school year in a fun yet relaxed way.

Field trips for this group will take place each Tuesday and Thursday, and they will also travel to the pool or water park on most Fridays. Camp tee shirts and wristbands ensure a safe yet exciting experience for them.



### Registration

Parents must register for all desired attendance weeks by May 1. The cost for each camp is \$260/week before May 1; after May 1, the cost is \$275/week or \$60/day and is subject to availability. Pricing includes breakfast, lunch, snack, and all field trips. Any weeks cancelled after May 1 will incur a ½ rate charge. Spots are limited and fill fast, so please register your child soon!
